removing GPA if below 3.0/4.0

Consider

Always have location and term (month and year) of experience

Format on right side of the page to keep resume uncluttered

Use PAST TENSE for all completed positions and PRESENT TENSE for all current positions

Use concise but

thorough bullet

position role

Always include

name and formal position title

organization

points to describe
