Economics Minor Information

The Minor in Economics enables students to conduct comprehensive study within the discipline of economics. It requires some depth within economics (18-21 hours), but is not as extensive as the Economics Majors (30-42 hours). Undergraduate students enrolled in a degree program at Illinois are not required to complete a minor for degree certification. However, many find this a desirable opportunity to study at some depth in a subject matter of additional interest to their major field of study. The Minor in Economics benefits students in all majors throughout campus who are unable to do a double major or dual degree in economics.

Economics is concerned with the creation, consumption, and transfer of wealth, important areas for all students to understand. The economics minor will increase students' understanding of Microeconomics, Macroeconomics, or Econometrics.

Please note: The Economics Minor requires criteria fulfilled prior to declaring, and an application submitted online through our website.

Application

- 1. Complete the Requirements to Apply for the intended Economics Minor Track (Microeconomics, Macroeconomics, or Econometrics)
 - a. All requirements must be complete and on your student record with the minimum criteria listed
 - b. No other criteria considered (other than student must be actively enrolled in an undergraduate major)
- 2. Complete the Online Application (available at the bottom of each of the Minor Track Website pages)
 - a. The application only requires you to sign-in, then complete a couple of short questions (expected graduation date, minor track requested, and confirm you have read and agree to the campus minor requirements)
- 3. Department Review
 - a. Economics Office will review your application and check that you have fulfilled the requirements to declare the requested minor track
 - b. Reviews are completed at least once per month
 - c. Students will receive an email with approve or not approve, and additional information (students not approved will receive details, such as a required course is not showing as complete, or grade/GPA required below minimum)
- 4. Approval
 - a. Students approved for the minor will have a campus minor form submitted to their college office, to be added to their record
 - b. Processing may take 1-2 weeks for the college office to update
